Summer Youth Employment Program

If you:

- Are 14-21 years old
- Live in the City of Los Angeles
- Have low to middle income
- Have a legal right to work in the U.S.

You may qualify to participate in the Summer Youth Employment Program. The program gives City youth 14-21 years of age an opportunity to learn job skills and earn a paycheck. Youth work with government offices, non-profit organizations or community agencies part-time for 6 weeks and earn \$8.00 an hour.

Program Eligibility:

- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- School ID
- Utility Bill
- Proof of Attendance: Title One School OR Proof of Income Eligibility

Program Requirements:

**Letter from DCFS or Probation: Verifying Foster Youth/Probation
Selective Service: 18 Year Old Males Only**
